

COMMUNION RITE

Lord's Prayer [STANDING]:

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread;
and forgive us our trespasses

as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Priest: Deliver us, Lord, from every evil...

All: For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours,
now and forever.

Sign of Peace:

Priest: Lord Jesus Christ... **All:** Amen.

Priest: The Peace of the Lord be with you always.

All: And also with you.

Preparation for Communion: [KNEELING or standing]:

All: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
have mercy on us.

Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
have mercy on us.

Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world:
grant us peace.

Priest: This is the Lamb of God...

All: Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,
but only say the word and I shall be healed.

Communion (for those who are ready to receive it):

Priest: The body of Christ. **Communicant:** Amen.

Personal prayer in Silence [SITTING OR KNEELING]:

Prayer after Communion [STANDING]:

Priest: Let us pray... **All:** Amen.

CONCLUDING RITE

Blessing & Dismissal [STANDING]:

Priest: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.

Priest: May almighty God bless you, the Father, and the Son,
and the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

Priest: Go in the peace of Christ (or similar).

All: Thanks be to God!

MASS IN ENGLISH

INTRODUCTORY RITES

Priest: In the name of the Father, and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit. [STANDING]

All: Amen.

Priest: The Lord be with you. (or another greeting)

All: And also with you.

Penitential Rite:

All: I confess to almighty God,
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have sinned through my own fault,
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done,
and in what I have failed to do;
and I ask blessed Mary, ever virgin,
all the angels and saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord, our God.

Priest: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins,
and bring us to everlasting life. **All:** Amen.

Priest: Lord, have mercy. **All:** Lord, have mercy.

Priest: Christ, have mercy. **All:** Christ, have mercy.

Priest: Lord, have mercy. **All:** Lord, have mercy.

(Or: Kyrie, eleison, Christe eleison)

Gloria (Hymn of praise):

Priest: Glory to God in the highest,

All: and peace to his people on earth.

Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father,
we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.

Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father,

Lord God, Lamb of God,

you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us;

you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,

You alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ,

with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Opening Prayer:

Priest: Let us pray....

All: Amen.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First (and second) Reading - Response:

Lector: The Word of the Lord. **All: Thanks be to God! [SITTING]**

In between **Responsorial Psalm: all** repeat the Verse

Alleluia or Gospel Acclamation **[PLEASE STAND]:**

Cantor: Alleluia! **All: Alleluia!**

Cantor: [verse] **All: Alleluia!**

Priest: The Lord be with you. **All: And also with you.**

Priest: A reading from the Holy Gospel according to...
All: Glory to you, Lord!

After the Gospel Proclamation:

Priest: The Gospel of the Lord. **All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!**

Homily **[PLEASE SIT]**

Profession of Faith **[STANDING]:**

WE BELIEVE in one God, the Father, the Almighty,
maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God,
eternally begotten of the Father,

God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God,
begotten, not made, one in Being with the Father.

Through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven:

by the power of the Holy Spirit [bow during the two lines:]

he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;

he suffered, died, and was buried.

On the third day he rose again in fulfillment of the Scriptures;
he ascended into heaven and

is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead,
and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father and the Son.

With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified.

He has spoken through the Prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.

We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.

We look for the resurrection of the dead,

and the life of the world to come. Amen.

General Intercessions / Prayer of the Faithful:

Priest: ...let us pray to the Lord. **All: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Or: ...Lord, hear us. **All: Lord graciously hear us.**

LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

Presentation of the Gifts: **[PLEASE SIT]**

Priest: Blessed are you, Lord, God of all creation... (2x)

All: Blessed be God for ever.

Priest: Pray, my brothers and sisters, that our sacrifice
may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

**All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, [STANDING]
for the praise and glory of his name,
for our good, and the good of all his Church.**

Prayer over the Gifts: ... All: Amen.

EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Preface Dialogue: **[STANDING]**

Priest: The Lord be with you. **All: And also with you.**

Priest: Lift up your hearts. **All: We lift them up to the Lord.**

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God.

All: It is right to give him thanks and praise.

Holy, Holy (Sanctus):

**All: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.**

Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

Hosanna in the highest.

Consecration **[KNEEL or stand]**

Memorial Acclamation **[STANDING or kneeling]:**

Priest: Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:

All: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.

Doxology and Great Amen **[STANDING]:**

Priest: Through him, with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
all glory and honor is yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.

All: Amen!
